Dear Wade:

In our recent conversations regarding ongoing threats by some congregations, including the congregation of St. Andrew's, Mount Pleasant, to withdraw their parishes from the Episcopal Diocese of South Carolina and The Episcopal Church, you have indicated that the Diocese will cooperate with the Church's efforts to gather historical and other information about St. Andrew's, in particular, by providing copies of certain records maintained by the Diocese. Accordingly, I am writing respectfully to request that you send me copies of the following documents related to St. Andrew's:

Charlotte
Columbia
Greensboro
Greenville
Hilton Head
Myrtle Beach

1. Minutes of the Standing Committee reflecting its agreement to the recent conveyance of St. Andrew's real property;
2. Any document reflecting the recordation of a mortgage on St. Andrew's property;
3. St. Andrew's original corporate charter, and all later amendments;
4. St. Andrew's original by-laws, and all later amendments;
5. Documents reflecting the founding of St. Andrew's as a parish (such as a petition by the congregation) and any record of diocesan action on the petition;

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6. Documents showing St. Andrew's participation in diocesan programs (such as insurance);
7. Documents showing requests by St. Andrew's for consent of the Bishop and Standing Committee to the alienation encumbrance of real property; or
8. Documents reflecting the consecration of St. Andrew's property;
9. Documents reflecting installations of rectors at St. Andrew's by the Bishop;
10. Deeds to St. Andrew's property; and
11. Copies of any and all mortgages to the Diocese from the current owners of property in connection with the property transfer that occurred in 2009.

I will be glad to inspect and copy these documents at the Diocesan office or at your office or in the way most convenient to you, and this is true with regard to all of the multiple requests we are making along these lines
