Commission On Ministry

Ecclesiastical Court

A court of six presbyters and five laity, elected by Diocesan Convention, to hear such complaints of misconduct as may be brought against clergy of the Diocese

One Dean is appointed to represent each of the six deaneries-organizes regular gatherings for prayer and encouragement amongst clergy and serves together as a Council of Advice to the Bishop

Purpose is to promote Christian Knowledge, learning and piety in the Diocese.
