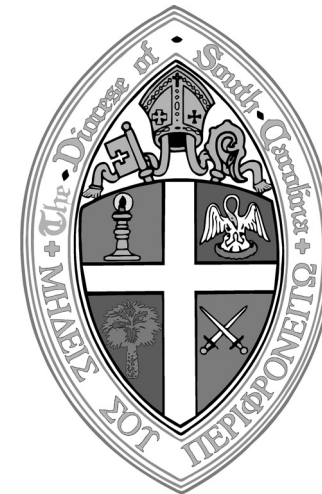

### Youth Ministry for the Small Parish/Mission

The future of the church depends on our faithfulness in raising up disciples from the younger generations. Youth ministry is vitally important to our pursuit of the Great Commission and is a major pipeline for future leaders.

At the same time, youth ministry within small churches, by necessity and design, will look different

than youth ministry in larger and established churches. This workshop will highlight alternative models for youth ministry that take advantage of the strengths of small churches to reach and disciple teenagers for Jesus Christ. We will look at a strategy that can:

- Meet the needs of every generation
- Be taught and implemented in churches regardless of size or context
- Be initiated without programs, budgets, and extensive resources
- Be faithful to God's plan for the propagation of the gospel

### Insurance Services

Every congregation in the Diocese is subject to risk. The question is not, "does it exist" but rather how does one manage it. Every congregation should do a regular review of their risk management program to assure that all areas of concern are being properly and adequately addressed.

A year ago, the Diocese of South Carolina launched a new program to

provide our parishes with a comprehensive program of property and casualty insurance. Since that time, the program has been expanded and options added to accommodate our inland congregations as well.

Mr. Billy Mills (Wells Fargo Insurance Services) will be providing a synopsis of the components parishes should be considering in a good risk management plan. He will also be available to answer questions about the specifics of the Diocesan Property and Casualty program and how it can benefit all our congregations.
