Your letter of September 30, 2011 to the President of the Standing Committee of the Diocese of South Carolina has been referred to me in my capacity as Chancellor of the Diocese. Before addressing its substance, it would be very helpful to me if you would please clarify the following matters:

1. Are your requests being made under the provisions of the 2006 or the 2009 Canons?
2. Please clarify the capacity in which you are writing? You are listed as a member of the Disciplinary Board for Bishops on its roster, with your term expiring in 2015, but you also identify yourself as "Church Attorney" Canons IV.5.3(c) and IV. 17.2(a) (2009) prohibit a member of the Disciplinary Board for Bishops from serving as Church Attorney and a Church Attorney from serving as member of the Disciplinary Board for Bishops. The 2006 Canons have provisions that operate in a similar fashion. Please clarify your role.
