What began as a summer camp program for disadvantaged children in 1938 along the shores of “Seabrook’s Beach” has become a full year round operation of both camp and conference center that annually serves over 15,000 children in our summer camp and barrier island education programs, and thousands more through our conference facilities.

In recognition of this milestone achievement, a three day celebration is planned at St. Christopher for Saturday, June 22 through Monday, June 24. Over the course of this three day celebration, St. Christopher will offer a 5K Run & Hike throughout the grounds of beach and maritime forest; an Open House to explore the campus, enjoy waterfront activities, and view a history exhibit; a Summer Staff Reunion Sailing Regatta; and a Gala Dinner with both silent and live auction. A time capsule buried at the 50th Anniversary will also be recovered which is known to include many artifacts and a video record of that era. God willing, the video will be shown at the Gala Dinner along with other special presentations.
